

Chioma Agwuegbo is Executive Director at TechHerNG and Convener of the #StateofEmergencyGBV Movement, a coalition of organisations igniting citizens to advocate for an urgent, comprehensive, and sustainable response to SGBV. Chioma believes in applying digital solutions to societal problems, whether it is co-creating solutions for sexual and gender-based violence, or curating digital freedoms/security sessions.

She has co-authored research for the MacArthur Foundation, Paris Peace Forum, Agora Policy, Digital Defenders Partnerships, and Ford Foundation. TechHer currently delivers its flagship digital literacy project in 17 local education authority schools in peri-urban communities in the FCT and has

a robust body of work around online gender-based violence.

TechHer also administers Nigeria's first SGBV Emergency Fund with Education as A Vaccine (EVA), with a 24-hour turnaround time for supporting survivors.

Chioma has a Master's Degree in Social Media and a first degree in Mass Communication. She serves on the boards of PLAN International Nigeria and OXFAM International.
